Roscoe Douglas, Rebekah Dawson's SIL's father: stage 4 colon cancer, lung tumors, has lived 2 1/2 years despite being given only 6 months at diagnosis, treating with only Proton therapy, vitamins, and diet changes, quality of life very good, recovering from recent hip operation. Andrew McCall, 8-yr-old son of Rev. & Mrs. Perry McCall: acute leukemia.
