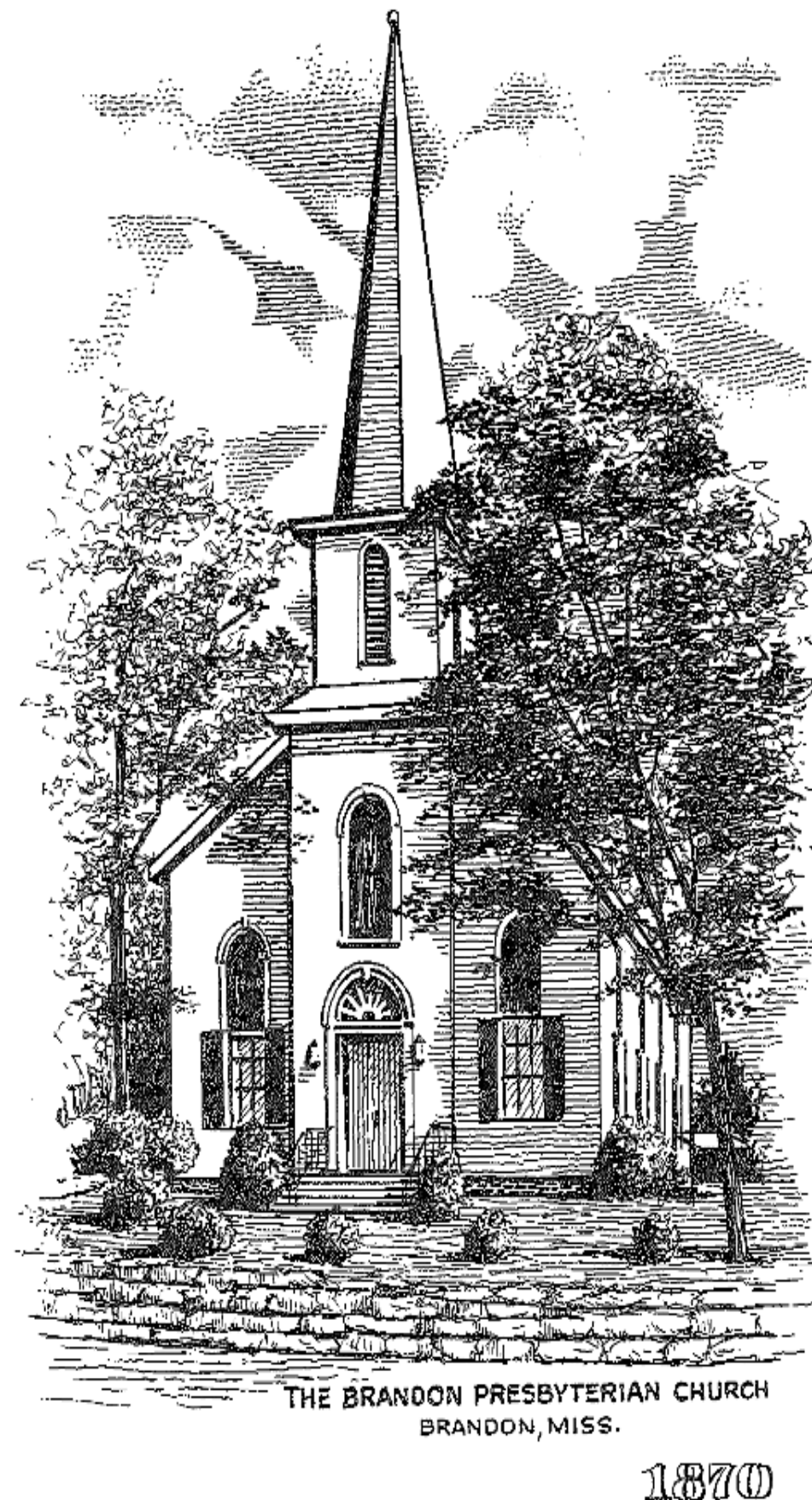

Loved ones battling cancer:

- **Andrew McCall** (Son of Rev. & Mrs. Perry McCall): acute leukemia; celebrated his 16th birthday, in Jan. He had a good cancer clinic visit on Jan. 10; all blood counts were good. Nex checkup and Cat scan in May. He also has severe sleep apnea and Avascular Necrosis in his ankles & knees. Thank you for your continued prayers.
- **Andrew Gerrard** (Jo Stanford's nephew): his latest scan at MDA showed that his cancer remains stable. Praise to God! Since he is at the end of the line with standard DSRCT protocols, he is going to have to move to more experimental drugs. There is a trial available that he is eligible for... not specifically for DSRCT, but it does target the NTRK gene fusion. His cancer translocation signals the NTRK and the drug on trial blocks the NTRK. His doctor say that this drug has the potential to help him. Insurance approval should come in the next 2 weeks, so he should be able to start the trial soon after. The plan is for him to participate in the trial in Nashville. Please pray for all logistics to work out smoothly if it is God's will for Andrew to participate in this trial.
- **Jim Smith:** pancreatic cancer; doing well. Jim's December 14 scan was stable. We want to thank our BPC family for all the prayer support. We are so thankful for these blessings.
