

Second Helvetic Confession XVII – "Of the Catholic and Holy Church of God, and of the One Only Head of the Church"

Forasmuch as God from the beginning would have men to be saved, and to come to the knowledge of the truth (1 Tim. 2:4), therefore it is necessary that there always should have been, and should be at this day, and to the end of the world, a Church—that is, a company of the faithful called and gathered out of the world; a communion, I say, of all saints, that is, of them who truly know and rightly worship and serve the true God, in Jesus Christ the Savior, by the word of the Holy Spirit, and who by faith are partakers of all those good graces which are freely offered through Christ.
