

Confession of Faith / Catechesis

Second Helvetic Confession XVII. Of the Catholic and Holy Church of God, and of the One Only Head of the Church (Part 5)

This holy Church of God is called "the temple of the living God" (2 Cor. 6:16), built of "living stones,...a spiritual house" (1 Pet. 2:5), founded upon a rock (Matt. 16:18), "which cannot be moved" (Heb. 12:28), upon a foundation besides which none can be laid (1 Cor. 3:11), and therefore it is called "the pillar and bulwark of the truth" (I Tim. 3:15). It does not err as long as it rests upon the rock Christ, and upon the foundation of the prophets and apostles. And it is no wonder if it errs, as often as it deserts him who alone is the truth. This Church is also called "a virgin" (2 Cor. 11:2), and the Bride of Christ (Songs 4:8), and his "beloved" (Songs 5:16). For the apostle says: "I betrothed you to Christ to present you as a pure bride to Christ" (2 Cor. 11:2). The Church is called a flock of sheep under the one shepherd, Christ (Ezek. 34:22-23; John 10:16). It is also called the body of Christ (Col. 1:24), because the faithful are living members of Christ under Christ the Head.
