

Like the burning bush, God never runs out of fuel. His glory never dims; his beauty never fades. He always keeps burning bright. This is because God does not get his energy from anyone or anything outside himself. He is completely self-existent and self-sufficient in his eternal being. According to Gregory of Nyssa (330-c.395), what Moses saw in the burning bush was nothing less than "the transcendent essence and cause of the universe, on which everything depends, alone subsists." The burning bush revealed the power and the glory, the eternity and the self-sufficiency of God.
